

## **FAQs on Healthcare Graduate Studies Awards**

### **Eligibility Criteria**

#### **1. Who is eligible for the award?**

You must be a Singapore citizen or Permanent Resident (who is prepared to take up citizenship) with a good university degree and have strong involvement in co-curricular activities such as school activities, volunteer work, community services etc.

Favourable consideration will be given to candidates who have confirmed admission to relevant graduate courses (local or overseas).

#### **2. What attributes should applicants possess?**

In addition to the eligibility criteria stated above, the successful candidate ideally should be a dynamic and versatile individual with an inquisitive and enquiring mind. Equally important, one should demonstrate passion, interest and commitment in developing Singapore's healthcare system.

#### **3. Are final year undergraduates eligible for the award?**

Yes. Final year undergraduates are welcome to apply.

#### **4. I have already accepted a scholarship. Am I still eligible for Healthcare Graduate Studies Award?**

To apply for the award, you must not be a recipient of any existing scholarships or grants that carries a bond. However, recipients of scholarships or grant that do not carry a bond are eligible for the Healthcare Graduates Studies Award. Applicants should declare any existing grants or scholarships held during the application phase.

### **Application Process**

## **Terms and Conditions**

### **1. What does the award cover?**

The sponsorship includes full support for all related costs for the duration of the course of study. This would include coverage of full tuition fees, monthly maintenance allowances, annual book allowances, hostel allowances and settling-in allowances. For students on local sponsorship, the settling-in allowance is only valid for students staying in hostels.

Students on overseas sponsorships would be granted further allowances in the form of health and travel insurance (if compulsory for visa application), return economy class airfare as well as warm clothing allowances.

### **2. Will I be required to serve out a bond?**

Yes. The bond duration varies with the period and country of study. For details on the bond period, please see table 1 below:

Table 1: Bond Period

<b>Period of Study</b>	<b>Local Award</b>	<b>Overseas Award</b>
Up to 12 months of Study	2 Years	3 Years
Between 12 and 18 months of study	3 Years	4 Years
More than 18 months of study	4 Years	5 Years

### **3. What career opportunities are available to me when I graduate?**

As a recipient of the Healthcare Graduate Studies Award, you will have the opportunity to work in the Ministry of Health, MOH Holdings, restructured hospitals, national specialty centres and research institutions.

### **4. How many awards are given out annually?**

The total number of awards granted each year will depend on the calibre of applicants.
